We have a problem: the combustion of coal keeps fueling the global climate crisis. However, Germany's federal government ignores its very own climate targets and delays the coal phase-out.

Till after 2040, entire villages are to be relocated and ecosystems are to be destroyed for the lignite coal mines near Leipzig. But the lignite coal company MIBRAG wants more: without any legal basis, the village of Pödelwitz is planned to be next to vanish for coal.

With many hundreds of people, we will sit in the way of the climate-damaging lignite industry and demand: "RePlace coal!"

From young to old, from experienced activists to complete newbies to the blockade: in our low-threshold action of civil disobedience, we will organize ourselves within affinity groups and empower one another. We act collectively and with determination and keep up the blockades even when being faced with requests by the police.

As a part of the global climate justice movement, we support the local lignite coal resistance. On the Leipziger Land climate camp, strategies of societal change will be exchanged and applied in practice during the week before the action.
